

Usage: My antivirus detects CERTivity as a threat

For some reason, certivity.exe 32 bit Windows launcher may be reported as a threat by few antivirus programs (currently 2 out of 50 on [virustotal](#)). This is a false positive detection, many others reporting the Heuristic.LooksLike.Win32.Suspicious.J!89 as a false positive. Rest assured this launcher is created by the NetBeans platform RPC and follows the [recommended way of branding the icon](#). The 64-bit certivity64.exe has no false positive detection on [virustotal](#).

If that is the case and your antivirus on Windows 32 platforms is either deleting certivity.exe (there is nothing in CERTivity 2.0/bin/ directory) or refuse to launch it then create an exception rule for CERTivity application launcher (certivity.exe).

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
